- This section will always filter by the product lines that have already been moved to 'In Library' status.
  - These are the product lines that are ready to be downloaded at any time.
  - You can remove In Library filter to view all by clicking the X next to In Library.
- If you select a product line then click deliver, the data will go to your dedicated ftp site you have set up in the admin section.
  - Note: if there is not an FTP set up, it will attempt to transfer via email; however, it may not be able to be delivered via email if the file size is too large.
  - If or when a Supplier sets a product line up as "Auto Publish", and they have already given you access to that product line & you've moved it to 'In Library', when they import any new data it will automatically push through to your default delivery destination and if it is pushed to an FTP you will receive an automated email notification from OptiCat letting you know it's waiting for you.
- Click the product line and then deliver all the data in the product line will be deliverer. In some cases a product line could contain numerous files. By clicking the blue + they can select the desired files individually by choosing the product line and the selected file(s) needed.
- The publish column will define if the supplier has set to Auto Publish, it will read Auto Deliver. If not it will read Click Deliver, meaning they will need to download the data as needed.

- You can filter by the following:
  - **Need Authorization-** This means you have not requested to access this product line.
  - Access Requested-This means you have requested access to the product line, but the supplier has not yet given you permission.
    - Note: The Supplier Manager's contact information is provided so that you can reach out to them with questions or if you are waiting on them to grant permission. If you do not see all the contact information, click on the blue plus sign to view.
  - **Access Authorized-** This means that the supplier has given you permission to access the data and you need to move it to 'In Library' in order to download.
  - In Library- This means you can download the data and will receive any future updates from the supplier if they use auto-publish or manually publish.
  - **Receiver Holding-**This means that you do not want data to be automatically delivered to you at this time.
    - You may deliver data to yourself while it is in 'Receiver Holding' status. Just highlight the product line by clicking, then select the 'deliver' box.
  - **Receiver Unwanted-**This means that you no longer want the data.
    - This will remove supplier authorization and access; you will need to re-request the data if needed in the future. You will be prompted to verify that you would like to delete this line from your Library.

## **IMAGE SYNC**

Image Sync is a feature of OnDemand that allows receivers to set specifications and specific file names to image files and digital assets that are being delivered. This includes file format, image dimensions, and file renaming. Net Changes is also another feature that can be used in the setup of Image Sync.

#### **Prerequisites:**

- Image Sync must be enabled by the Supplier for the images and digital assets data packages.
- Image Sync needs to be enabled in OnDemand for the Receiver.
- Receiver must have an FTP delivery storage repository to deliver images to.
- Each Product Line that is set up for Image Sync requires a unique, separate directory.
- Each Image Product Line must be configured to use Image Sync as its method of delivery.

## ISS Lite (Image Sync Service)

OptiCat saw the need to simplify how to send and receive images in a more efficient way. Previously a supplier would upload a ".zip" file with all images. Then, if there were any changes made to that file, a new ".zip" file needed to be reloaded, even if the file had only changed by 1 image. Image Sync Service (ISS) simplifies how this works. OptiCat takes the supplier's image folder and unzips the images that are then hosted in our FTP. Receivers then set up individual subfolders on their ftp that are dedicated to each line that they want to set up for Image Sync. Receivers then do an initial sync to their subfolder to receive all images unzipped. The next time there is an update in accordance with the receiver's sync preferences, we only add the net changes. The receiver is notified of any images that the supplier removed.

ISS Lite vs ISS Regular:

**ISS Regular** 

- You store the images on your ftp and OptiCat will add/subtract net changes
- This requires a large ftp storage space

#### ISS Lite

- You remove the images from your ftp after a sync and store them elsewhere.
- OptiCat only adds new images and emails you about any deletes.

Features & Facts:

The initial sync typically takes a longer time than updates, depending on how big the file is. Our ISS feature will save all the images to your designated FTP folder. The syncs from then on will vary on how many changes were done to that original master file.

File conversion takes about 1 second per file (per our latest testing).

ISS allows resizing of the images. The desired width or height can be selected, and the original aspect ratio will be preserved. We recommend a selection of width: 1500 in accordance with the Autocare best practices.

ISS allows file renaming; this is limited to the data included in the PIES<sup>™</sup> file. All of these settings can be accessed by going to OnDemand>Admin>Manage Image Sync Settings.

If destination folder does not exist on your FTP server, then our system can only create it for you if permissions are allowed.
